AMENDMENT TO OPERATING LICENSE  
NORTH ANNA POWER STATION UNIT NO. 1

Pursuant to 10CFR50.90, the Virginia Electric and Power Company hereby requests an amendment to Operating License No. NPF-4 for North Anna Power Station Unit 1. The proposed change is in response to Mr. Parr's letters of July 31, 1979 concerning secondary water chemistry control for North Anna 1 and 2. This revision would delete Technical Specification 3/4 7.1.6, and add a new license condition 2.D.(3)o, as shown in Attachment 1. This request supercedes our previous application of November 9, 1978.

A description of our secondary water chemistry monitoring and control program is provided in Attachment 2. Appropriate procedures and administrative controls will be developed to implement this program. We believe the program, as described, will ensure that secondary water chemistry is properly monitored and controlled.

This amendment request has been reviewed and approved by the Station Nuclear Safety and Operating Committee and the System Nuclear Safety and Operating Committee. It has been determined that this request does not involve an unreviewed safety question, as defined in 10CFR50.59.

Since the secondary water chemistry control program will be the same for Units 1 and 2, the attached proposed license condition should also appear in the Unit 2 operating license when it is issued.


