
Dear Chairman Deale:

Enclosed, you will find the revised testimony of Jim Lazar on Financial Qualification.

With respect to our testimony relating to the issues of Radon 222 and the environmental consequences of the Uranium Fuel Cycle, SCANP anticipates filing the prefiled testimony of Dr. Ruth Weiner, Western Washington State University, by the latter part of this week. SCANP will request the Board's permission to allow Dr. Weiner to conduct cross-examination on its behalf. SCANP is continuing its efforts to locate and make available other witnesses who will address this issue, and will prefile their testimony as soon as it becomes available. These witnesses will address the issues raised in Intervenor SCANP's Response to Partial Initial Decision in Perkins, which pleading was resubmitted to the Board recently. In addition, SCANP may request the Board to issue a subpoena so that SCANP may present further testimony on the Radon issue.
