Dear Chairman Hendrie:

This letter is to express my concern about any move by the NRC to stop all construction at the Marble Hill Nuclear Power Station site near Madison, Indiana. While I share your desire to examine potential safety problems and resolve them where necessary, I do not support a complete work stoppage. The economic and energy consequences of such an action would be severe, considering the employment level and completion schedule at Marble Hill.

It is my understanding that NRC's investigation and evaluation of the management of construction activities by Public Service Indiana will conclude this week. I applaud your efforts to determine the roots of any problems and hope that they will be expeditiously and satisfactorily answered before any additional workers are forced off the job.

I would appreciate being kept informed of your activities with respect to Marble Hill. Your decisions will be very important to Indiana and to the Nation.
