1. Petitioner is a citizens' organization of persons who reside within an eight to fifteen mile radius of the Three Mile Island Nuclear Generating Station (TMI), and are thus directly affected by whatever action this Commission takes in regard to the restoration to service of TMI Unit One.

2. This petition is brought pursuant to section 2.802 of this Commission's regulations (10 CFR §2.802). It seeks an order directing the tribunal conducting the hearings of the restart of TMI-1 to specifically address and pass upon the issue of whether in light of information which includes but is not limited to the contents of NUREG 0600: Investigative Report No. 50-320/79-10, the licensee of TMI-1, Metropolitan Edison Co. has failed in its operation of TMI Unit Two to act in accordance with the terms and provisions of the Atomic Energy Act, the regulations of this Commission, and the applicable operating license (10 CFR §50.100). If its resolution of the foregoing issue is in the affirmative, the tribunal should then be directed to specifically address and pass upon the issue of whether Metropolitan Edison's operating license for TMI-1 should be revoked.
