Subject: Inservice Inspection Program Description

The Attachment to this letter reflects changes incorporated into the Vermont Yankee Inservice Inspection Program, Reference (b), as a result of on-site meetings with the NRC ISI review team.

This submittal is part of an overall program to modify Vermont Yankee's inservice inspection requirements to comply with 10 CFR 50.55a and ASME Section XI. A Class III fee of \$4,000.00 was previously submitted in Reference (c) to cover the licensing review associated with this program.

Vermont Yankee believes that the NRC revised fee schedule is illegal. We are aware that an appeal of the decision of the U. S. Court of Appeals for the Fifth Circuit is being considered and therefore submit the enclosed fee under protest without waiving its right to contest the validity of the fee or the entire NRC fee schedule, and without waiving any right to recover, in whole or in part, all fees paid or to be paid under the invalid fee schedule.
