
By order issued October 1, 1979, the Siting Board
stated its intention to dismiss this application on October 16,
1979 unless the Power Authority filed on or before that date
a statement of facts and arguments not previously advanced
demonstrating why continuation of this case would be in the
public interest. On October 16, 1979, the Power Authority
submitted a report that claims, for the first time, that
"Dismissal of the application at this time could have a
significant financial impact on the Authority and its cus-
tomers by impairing the Authority's ability to liquidate its
investment in the Greene County Nuclear Power Project."
