On Saturday, 9/7/19, Inwater Research Group (IRG) biologists captured and released an 11'6" smalltooth sawfish from the St. Lucie intake canal. Personnel from Harbor Branch assisted the capture. They inserted a sonic tag and a fin tag and data and samples were collected. The sawfish was in good condition and was released back to the ocean within 2 hours from capture time. FPL/IRG will monitor the beach in front of the power plant for the following 7 days as directed by the 2016 Biological Opinion. Please let us know if you have any questions.
