Gulf States Utilities outlined in the Preliminary Safety Analysis Report (pages R3-76, -77, -78, -79) its commitments for qualifying class IE equipment to IEEE 323-74. In this commitment, it is stated, "we (GSU) would expect to receive NRC review and approval of this information (qualification programs) via a continuing series of uniformly distributed meetings beginning post Construction Permit and continuing through the Operating License stage as equipment vendors are defined."

As part of this continuing effort, we are now submitting the qualification programs listed in attachment one for your review. All non-proprietary programs are attached to this letter also. Proprietary portions (when necessary) are noted as such on attachment one, and are submitted to you under separate cover with accompanying affidavits in accordance with part 2.790 of Title 10 of the Code of Federal Regulations. After your staff has reviewed these programs, we would like to schedule a meeting to discuss any comments they may have.
