Environmental Qualification of Class 1E Equipment

In accordance with the reporting requirements of Reference (1), Northeast Nuclear Energy Company (NNECO) informed the NRC Staff in Reference (2) that certain Resistance Temperature Detectors (RTD's) were not qualified for service in the LOCA environment.

Subsequent engineering reviews have substantiated the adequacy of the Reference (2) material and as such, the 14-day follow-up report is rendered superfluous.
