We urge the Commission to please grant the required full intervenor status to Mrs. Berryhill, so as to insure that the concerned citizens of the State of Delaware, have the proper representation in the matter of the re-licensing hearings of TMI Unit-1

During the TMI accident, Mrs. Berryhill's diligent, courageous effort, in the handling and dispensing of pertinent information, accumulated through years of self-sacrifice, was an asset to the system in quelling the fears, and ignorance of unknowing citizens in this potentially disastrous situation.
