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APPLICATION FOR AMENDMENT
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Philadelphia Electric Company, Licensee under Facility Operating License DPR-44 for Peach Bottom Atomic Power Station Unit No. 2 and Licensee under Facility Operating License DPR-56 for Peach Bottom Atomic Power Station Unit No. 3, hereby requests that the Technical Specifications contained in Appendix A of the Operating Licenses be amended to correct an administrative oversight in a previous amendment request by deleting from Table 3.11.D.1 snubbers 3-HC-S-1 and 3-HC-S-2 for each unit. The

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revisions are indicated by vertical bars in the right margin of the attached copies of page 234i for Units 2 and 3.

The snubbers are located on a portion of the CRD return line. They have been physically removed on Unit 3 during the current refueling and maintenance outage and are scheduled to be removed on Unit 2 during the 1980 Spring refueling outage as part of a modification to the CRD return line that has been reviewed and approved by the Nuclear Regulatory Commission in Technical Specification Amendments Nos. 60 to the Peach Bottom Units 2 and 3 Operating Licenses. It is therefore requested that Unit 3 snubbers 3-HC-S-1 and 3-HC-S-2 be deleted from Table 3.11.D.1. Since the CRD modification to Unit 2 will not be performed until after these Technical Specification changes have been approved, it is requested that deletion of Unit 2 snubbers 3-HC-S-1 and 3-HC-S-2 be made effective upon completion of the CRD modification.

Since the proposed changes to the Technical Specifications are administrative in nature, pursuant to 10 CFR 170.22. Philadelphia Electric Company, for fee purposes, proposes that the Application for Amendment for Unit No. 2 be considered a Class II Amendment and that the Application for Amendment for Unit 3 be considered a Class I Amendment.






