SirSpheres on to NRC License No.: 06-01060-01 / 03001247**

Gentlemen & women of the NRC:

Bridgeport Hospital would like amend NRC License No.: 06-01060-01 to add Dr. Juan Carlos Perez Lozada (J.C. Perez Lozada, M.D.) as an Authorized User (AU) for Y-90 microspheres (SirSpheres) under 10 CFR 35.1000.

Dr. Perez Lozada is currently listed as an AU for Y-90 SirSpheres on the Yale New Haven Hospital (YNHH) NRC Broad Scope License (NRC Lic. No.: 06-00819-03). We have attached a letter from the YNHH Radiation Safety Committee documenting his current status as an AU on the YNHH NRC License.

Also, since Dr. Perez Lozada is currently an AU for the use of Y-90 SirSpheres on the YNHH license we would also like to authorize him to act as a visiting AU, under the provisions of 10 CFR 35.14 (a), while the amendment is in progress.

It is my pleasure to inform you that at the last meeting of the Yale-New Haven Hospital Radiation Safety Committee, on July 18, 2018, your credentials were presented and approved by the committee for the following areas of byproduct material use:

10 CFR Part 35.300 (I-131 for thyroid cancer & hyperthyroidism)

10 CFR Part 35.1000 (Y-90 Sir-Spheres)

The Committee has determined that you meet the training and experience requirements specified in sections (b)(1), (2) & (3) (preceptor statements) for 10 CFR 35.300 (radiopharmaceuticals requiring a written directive), in addition we have documentation showing that you have been trained in the use of Y-90 Sir-Spheres by a Sirtex representative and have been proctored for three cases, one case with a Sirtex proctor, Dr. Eric Reiner and two cases under the supervision of Dr. Raj. Ayyagari, who is an AU for Y-90 Sir-Spheres use, on the YNHH staff.

Therefore, you are hereby approved as an Authorized User under the NRC Broad Scope License No.: 06-00819-03, to use byproduct material radioisotope sources for the previously described uses. Although, you can now begin to practice in these areas of use, please be sure to familiarize yourself with our local policies, procedures and practices before initial independent use.
