Subject: **Emergency Plan Change Performed Under 10 CFR 50.54(q)**

The UFTR has revised Table 10.1, Decontamination Room Emergency Equipment Inventory, effective September 10, 2019, removing the outdated equipment. Specifically, the change removes obsolete Self-Contained Breathing Apparatuses (SCBA's) and D-Cell batteries from the inventory.

If needed, UFTR relies on the Gainesville Fire Department (GFD) to provide firefighting and lifesaving actions within a radiological environment (Ref: Emergency Plan Sections 3.4.2, 10.1.1, 10.1.2). The GFD is equipped with proper SCBA's and personnel trained in their use. This change to the inventory is consistent with UFTR Emergency Procedure guidance which directs personnel to evacuate the building then implement call-lists to summon the level of emergency support needed (Refs: SOP-B.1, Radiological Emergency, and SOP-B.2, Emergency Procedure-Fire).

Maintaining D-Cell batteries in the inventory is also no longer needed since the current dosimeter chargers and survey meters no longer require D-Cell batteries to function.

These inventory changes have no negative impact on the UFTR emergency response and therefore no reduction in emergency response effectiveness results from these changes.
