Gentlemen:

The referenced letter submits our application for an amendment to the Calvert Cliffs Unit No. 1 Operating License to allow operation during the fourth cycle. Pursuant to 10CFR Part 170 paragraph 170.22, we hereby submit a check in the amount of \$12,300.00 corresponding to the prescribed fee for a Class IV amendment.

We have determined this to be a Class IV amendment inasmuch as it involves several issues: The replacement of fuel in the core with accompanying parameter adjustments; the use of CEA guide tube sleeves; the use of modified CEA guide tube flow holes; the introduction of the SCOUT extended burnup program; and modifications to the technical specifications and accident analyses.
