
Peter Anderson, being first duly sworn, on oath deposes and states as follows:

1. That he attended as one of the representatives of Wisconsin's Environmental Decade, Inc., the November 28, 1979, meeting of the U. S. Nuclear Regulatory Commission.

2. That Commissioners Ahearne and Bradford asked him questions during said meeting as to the adequacy of Wisconsin Electric Power Company's proposed "package" of testing, surveillance and monitoring measures to minimize risk from operation of Point Beach Nuclear Plant Unit 1 with steam generator tube degradation.

3. That, in response to said questions, he stated that for reasons unrelated to this affidavit, the "package" would not provide satisfactory assurance that the risks would be minimized.

4. That, after the conclusion of said meeting, Mr. Edson G. Case, Acting Director of the Office of Nuclear Reactor Regulation privately came up to him and stated that he agreed that the "package" would not provide the kind of adequate protection represented due to the high rate of corrosion and the existence of caustic stress corrosion.
