Hello Mr. Manfrey,

One of the debtors (Lakeshore Toltest) in the LTC Holdings, Inc. bankruptcy case (14-11111-CSS in D. Del.) is a specific and general licensee in possession of gauges that contain material regulated by the U.S. Nuclear Regulatory Commission. For background information, please see the attached notice of NRC requirements filed in 2014. Licensing staff at the NRC was recently made aware of pending efforts to transfer these gauges and would like to hold a brief conference call with you and any other necessary participants to be sure that you all are aware of the permissible means by which to transfer these gauges. Once the gauges are transferred in accordance with NRC requirements, the licensing staff would also like to terminate the license, which will require some additional information (e.g., most recent leak test results) from Lakeshore Toltest, or the Chapter 7 trustee, whomever can provide it. Please let me know your availability next week for a 30-minute conference call and I can schedule it. Thank you.
