Mr. Stickler:

I am acknowledging receipt of your email.

I will continue review of your responses, but I see that you did not include a copy of a possession license from the state of Kentucky. In your application you described a subsidiary of Federal Resources Supply Company, KD Analytical Consulting, LLC, 5751 Briar Hill Road, Lexington KY 40516, as a location of use. You did not explicitly state that you intend to distribute to exempt persons from this location. If no distribution to exempt persons will occur from this location, or if you initially distribute from the Maryland location to

the Kentucky location, in effect using the Kentucky location as a warehouse, then you need not provide the Kentucky possession license.

Please indicate what your intentions are with respect to the Kentucky location, and if applicable, provide a copy of a possession license from the state of Kentucky.
