SUBJECT: CONSENT TO INDIRECT CHANGE OF CONTROL FOR ATC GROUP SERVICES LLC, NRC LICENSE NOS. 13-17732-01, 21-32807-01, AND 24-35467-01

Dear Mr. Daniels:

By letter dated August 13, 2019, ATC Group Services LLC, submitted to the U. S. Nuclear Regulatory Commission (NRC) a Request for Consent to Indirect Change of Control of NRC Materials License Nos. 13-17732-01, 21-32807-01, and 24-35467-01 issued to ATC Group Services LLC. Your letter is available electronically from the Agencywide Documents Access and Management System (ADAMS) at Accession No. ML19226A347.

Based on the information provided, we understand that as a result of a proposed transaction between Atlas Technical Consultants Holdings LP and Boxwood Merger Corp., control of ATC Group Services LLC will indirectly be transferred to Boxwood Merger Corp. We further understand that this transfer will not result in any change to the licensee's name, licensed materials, persons using the license material, location of use of licensed material, or persons responsible for the licensee's radiation safety program.

Based on the above understandings and as more fully detailed in the enclosed NRC staff's Safety Evaluation Report which documents the NRC staff's review of the request, the NRC consents to the proposed indirect transfer of control. Please note that you will need to notify us promptly, in writing, after the transaction has been finalized and include a signed copy of the final agreement confirming completion of the transaction. With this information, we can issue an administrative amendment to your NRC license to reflect the transaction, if necessary. Please contact Erin J. An environmental assessment for this action is not required, since this action is categorically excluded under Title 10 of the Code of Federal Regulations (10 CFR) 51.22(c).
