


10 CFR 40.53 states in part that each person licensed under § 40.52 shall file a report with the Director, Office of Nuclear Material Safety and Safeguards by an appropriate method listed in § 40.5(a) on products transferred to other persons for use under § 40.13(c) or equivalent regulations of an agreement state.

Contrary to the above as of June 27, 2019, the licensee failed to file a report with the Director, Office of Nuclear Material Safety and Safeguards by an appropriate method listed in § 40.5(a) on products transferred to other persons for use under § 40.13(c) or equivalent regulations of an agreement state. Specifically the licensee failed to file a report, for transferring welding rods to other persons for use under § 40.13(c) or equivalent regulations of an agreement state, with the NRC for calendar year 2018.

This is a Severity Level IV violation (Enforcement Policy 6.3)

The licensee submitted a report to the inspector on October 6, 2019 and that report was forwarded to the Office of Nuclear Material Safety and Safeguards on October 15, 2019. The licensee stated that they will put a notice on their Microsoft Office calendar to provide a reminder to submit the annual report by January 31<sup>st</sup> of each year.
