Dear Mr. Reynolds:

This refers to your license amendment letter request dated October 9, 2019. Please find enclosed Amendment No. 3 authorizing a 5-year extension in accordance with the current 15-year term for licenses. You will notice that the format of the license has changed since Amendment No. 2 of your license was written in landscape view and there have been some minor wording changes in some of the license conditions. Also, license condition number 18 on Amendment No. 2 has been incorporated into the header of Amendment No. 3 so you will no longer see it in the body of the license on Amendment No. 3. Also, in reformatting the listing of sources and devices you communicated with the NRC on your letter dated October 9, 2019, that you no longer wanted to list Cs-137, Am-241, and Cf-252, sources that were used in gauges. Therefore, these line items were removed from your license and the conditions on your license associated with gauge use were not written into Amendment No. 3 (condition 16 and 17 of license Amendment No. 2).

An environmental assessment for this action was not required, since this action is categorically excluded under 10 CFR 51.22(c)(14).

Please review the enclosed document carefully and be sure that you understand and fully implement all the conditions incorporated into the amended license. You will be periodically inspected by the NRC. Failure to conduct your program in accordance with NRC regulations, license conditions, and representations made in your license application and supplemental correspondence with NRC will result in enforcement action(s) against you. This could include issuance of a Notice of Violation, or Imposition of a Civil Penalty, or an Order Suspending, Modifying or Revoking Your License as specified in the NRC Enforcement Policy. 
