EVALUATION

By application dated September 23, 2019, (Agencywide Documents Access and Management System Accession No. ML19281D429), the U.S. Department of Energy, Naval Reactors, requested renewal of Certificate of Compliance No. 6386, for the Model No. 235R001 transportation package.

The applicant did not request any changes to the package design, operating procedures, acceptance tests, or maintenance program of the package. Renewal of the certificate does not affect the ability of the package to meet the requirements of Title 10 of the *Code of Federal Regulations* (10 CFR) Part 71. The certificate has been renewed for an additional 5 years.

CONDITIONS

Condition No. 8 was revised to reflect the new expiration date of April 30, 2025. The "REFERENCES" section was revised to include the date of the letter requesting package renewal.

CONCLUSION

The certificate has been renewed for a 5-year term. These changes do not affect the ability of the package to meet the requirements of 10 CFR Part 71.
