Revised Draft Emergency Preparedness Plan

Gentlemen:

Enclosed are ten copies of the revised draft Emergency Preparedness Plan (EPP) for your review. The plan as submitted was prepared prior to the issuance of NUREG 0654, and therefore, all items from NUREG 0654 have not yet been incorporated into the plan. We plan to submit a final draft of this EPP by April 1, 1980. This final draft is not expected to include the appendices containing state and local plans. The preparation and approval of these state and local plans will be expedited to the extent that we can influence these governmental bodies to promptly respond.

Our existing Emergency Preparedness Plan (Chapter 57 of the BPS Operating Manual) and the FSAR, Appendix C, Section 8 require an annual drill in the use of the EPP. We request relief from the requirement to conduct an EPP drill under the existing plan until July, 1980, when we expect to have the proposed EPP approved and implemented. Since plant fuel movement activities are complete for this outage and the return to power operation is not anticipated until July, 1980, no degradation of plant safety nor any effect on the health and safety of the public will result from granting this request.
