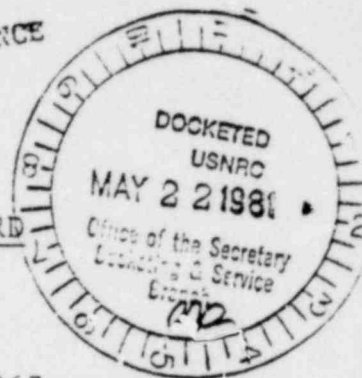

6. The deposition of Russell J. Bohn will be taken on Tuesday, July 28, 1981.



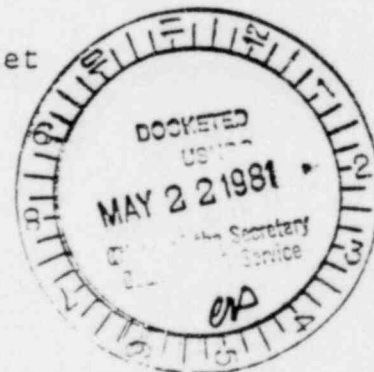
