

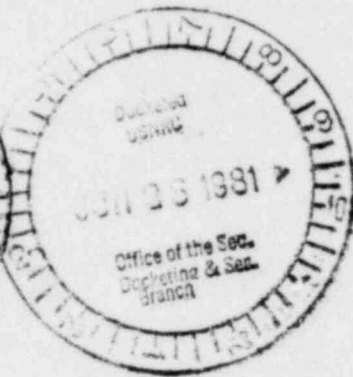
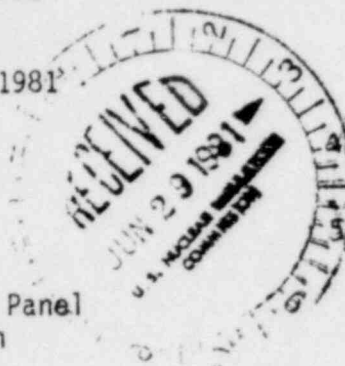

I am writing to request that you instruct South Carolina Electric & Gas Company to restore Fairfield United Action to the service list in the above-captioned proceeding pending final review of the Appeal Board decision, ALAB-642, 13 NRC ____ (June 1, 1981), reversing in part your earlier Order admitting FUA as Intervenor in this proceeding, LBP-81-11, 13 NRC ____ (April 30, 1981).
