### White Paper Purpose



- Provides guidance for adopting the voluntary option of conducting periodic emergency preparedness (EP) program reviews at a 24-month frequency as allowed by 10 CFR 50.54(t)(1)(ii)
  - Addresses the criteria and monitoring necessary to meet the regulatory requirements permitting a 24month review period; not intended to provide methods or instructions for conducting an EP program review
- Use would be voluntary, and other approaches to meeting the 24-month review requirements may also be acceptable

### NEI White Paper, Draft Revision D



- Submitted on 9/9/19
  - Requested NRC review followed by a discussion of staff comments in a public meeting
- Staff comments were discussed during a public meeting on 10/29/19
- White paper revised to address staff comments and submitted on 11/22/19, as Revision 0
  - Requesting NRC endorsement

#### Changes to Address NRC Comments



- Removed the option for assessing the adequacy of State and local interfaces through assessment of drill or exercise performance
- For definition of a change adversely affecting EP, replaced the criterion of a <u>precluded (lost) EP function</u> with <u>identification of a "reduction in effectiveness" without prior</u> <u>NRC approval</u>
- For Emergency Response Facility and Equipment Readiness (ERFER) indicator, replaced threshold based on 10 CFR 50.72 reports with one based on loss of an RSPS function (>24 hours with no comp measure)
- Editorial changes to improve readability
