SUBJECT: SUMMARY OF JANUARY 23, 2020, CLOSED PRE-SUBMITTAL
MEETING WITH RESEARCH AND PRODUCTION CORPORATION
RADICS LLC (EPID L-2019-TOP-0051)

On November 12, 2019, the U. S. Nuclear Regulatory Commission (NRC) staff held a closed teleconference with representatives of the Research and Production Corporation Radics LLC (RadICS). The purpose of the call was to discuss revisions to the RadICS digital instrumentation and control topical report. Information related to the meeting can be found in the Agencywide Documents and Access Management System (ADAMS) Package Accession No. ML20008C647.

At the meeting, RadICS discussed the reason for the supplement, the changes that were being made, and the plan for submittal of supplement. The NRC staff asked numerous technical questions to better understand the changes.

During the discussions, RadICS stated that its view was the supplement could be reviewed under the Topical Report with Minimal Revisions option (formally simplified safety evaluation) discussed at the October 24, 2019, workshop on topical report transformation. Information on the workshop can be found in ADAMS Package Accession No. ML19275G968.

The NRC staff agreed that the proposed supplement could likely be conducted under that option. Also, the NRC staff emphasized to RadICS that a lesson learned from the pilot was that scope creep has the potential to broaden the review and move it into a different process. However, based on the information provided, the NRC staff believed the review would be appropriate under the Topical Report with Minimal Revisions.

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The NRC staff further explained that in its submittal RadICS would have to address the criteria used to justify the Minimal Revisions option. Because there have been updates to the Minimal Revisions option, the NRC staff committed to provide RadICS the latest criteria. This was the lone action from the meeting.
