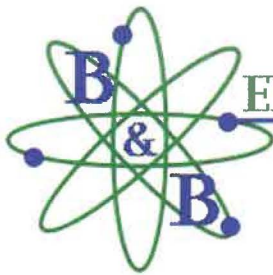

Dear Ms. Hill,

B & B Environmental Safety, Inc (BBES) does not plan to renew our NRC Radioactive Materials License # 04-29369-01 covering remediation, waste packaging and shipment. This license was issued in January 2010 and is due to expire on January 31, 2020.

Although it may again be a desire at a later time to have a NRC RAM license, we are currently redirecting our corporate business plans. And these efforts currently do not justify the license renewal. It is of course, understood that a new license filing will be required should a license be needed at a later time.

During the operations which were previously conducted under contract on client projects, all documentation was maintained and delivered to each client. At no time was radioactive material received or stored at BBES facilities. All materials under license control were maintained at client facilities.

As agreed to at the time of licensing, all operations were conducted IAW BBES Radiation Safety Program and communications were maintained with the NRC.

Greetings,

Please be advised that your Nuclear Materials License 04-29369-01, will expire on January 31, 2020. In order to prevent termination of your license, you MUST submit your renewal application so that it is received by the NRC no later than January 31, 2020. If you need to fax in your request in order to meet the submission deadline, you may fax it, to my attention, to 817-200-1083; and follow up with a hard copy through the mail. If your renewal request is not received by COB January 31, 2020, your license will, subsequently, expire, and you will have to divest yourself of any radioactive material before the expiration date, or commit to not using the radioactive material in NRC jurisdiction. If you make the commitment to not use the radioactive material in NRC jurisdiction, please give us a timeline of submitting a new license application (with applicable fee) or NRC Form 314, Certificate of Disposition of Material.

Please keep in mind that no fees need to be sent with a renewal application.
