I am writing to you as Executive Vice President of York Container Company and a concerned citizen living in the area of Three Mile Island.

In my opinion the concerns of the community in which we live and work have not necessarily been justly interpreted by the media reporting events in our area. Met-Ed's customers have a tremendous investment in the operation of Unit 1 at Three Mile Island. I think the time has come for someone to step forward and make a decision regarding the start up of Unit 1. We are all aware there are similar reactors being operated safely in many other locations throughout our country. I realize we are all concerned with the safety of this nuclear reactor, and our concern is that the situation can only deteriorate the longer it is delayed.

I strongly urge you to increase your efforts to prove Unit 1 is a safe nuclear reactor and allow it to begin operating as quickly as possible. The costs are simply too great to continue to let this power plant remain idle.
