The roads are narrow, winding with impossible egress.

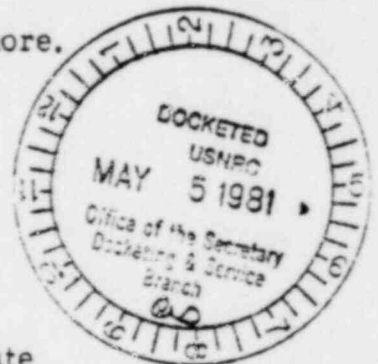
