AMENDMENT TO OPERATING LICENSES NPF-4 AND NPF-7
NORTH ANNA POWER STATION UNITS NO. 1 AND NO. 2
PROPOSED TECHNICAL SPECIFICATION CHANGE

Pursuant to 10 CFR 50.90, the Virginia Electric and Power Company requests an amendment, in the form of changes to the Technical Specifications, to Operating Licenses NPF-4 and NPF-7 for the North Anna Power Station, Units No. 1 and No. 2. The proposed changes are enclosed.

In a letter dated November 20, 1980 from Mr. Darrell G. Eisenhut to all power reactor licensees, we were requested to submit a license amendment application to incorporate applicable portions of the revised inservice surveillance requirements for snubbers in the Technical Specifications for North Anna Unit 1 and Unit 2. The proposed Technical Specifications changes are enclosed for Unit 1 and Unit 2 in Attachment 1 and Attachment 2, respectively. A discussion of the proposed changes is provided for Unit 1 and Unit 2 in Attachment 3 and Attachment 4, respectively.

This request has been reviewed and approved by the Station Nuclear Safety and Operating Committee and the Safety Evaluation and Control staff. It has been determined that this request does not involve an unreviewed safety question.


