- 150 feet from a 10-inch gas pipeline.

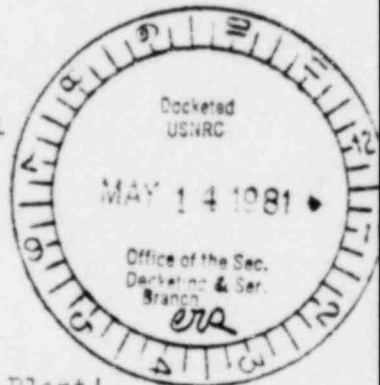
