Gentlemen:

By letter dated January 22, 1981 AP&L submitted Wylie Test Report #26304, and a supplement to the Report, to NRC as proprietary information per 10 CFR 2.790. Revision A to the report was later submitted by letter dated May 4, 1979, also as proprietary information. These reports describe the results of environmental qualification testing on certain Rosemount, Foxboro and Fischer and Porter pressure transmitters.

Since the submittal of this report both the technical and regulatory aspects of environmental qualification have changed significantly. Due to these developments, we no longer feel that the release of these documents would create an unfair competitive advantage to industry. In addition, we feel that this information may be of use to utilities seeking to comply with NRC regulations in this area. Therefore, please be informed that Arkansas Power & Light no longer considers the subject documents to be proprietary information.
