IE Bulletin 80-23, dated November 14, 1980, entitled "Failures of Solenoid Valves Manufactured by Valcor Engineering Corporation requested a determination of whether or not any Valcor solenoid valves having P/N's V70900-21-1 or -3 are used to perform any safety related function.

Mississippi Power & Light Company has completed a thorough review for all portions of the Grand Gulf Nuclear Station and determined that no Valcor solenoid valves having P/N's V70900-21-1 or -3 are installed or are planned to be used to perform any safety-related functions. Therefore, no additional action pursuant to IE Bulletin 80-23 is planned by Mississippi Power & Light Company for Grand Gulf Nuclear Station.

Pursuant to your request for an estimate of manpower expended in the conduct of the review and preparation of a response, Mississippi Power & Light Company estimates that approximately 20 man-hours were expended.
