Plan includes spending reductions  
of up to 65% on energy conservation,  
but maintains the annual \$1.5 billion  
subsidy of the nuclear power industry  
despite the fact that conservation could  
save nearly four times as much  
energy as nuclear power will  
produce in the next twenty years.
