100% of the membership interests of XCEL NDT, LLC were transferred from Cole Morehead to Crossbridge Merger Sub, LLC on March 6, 2019. See attached for the current organizational chart. The License is still held by XCEL NDT, LLC and the name will not be changed. Immediately following closing, Cole Morehead will continue to operate XCEL NDT, LLC with the same personnel used by him prior to the closing. It is not contemplated at the present time that changes will be made to XCEL NDT, LLC's organization, location, facilities, equipment or procedures. XCEL NDT LLC's surveillance program in regards to all equipment maintenance and equipment monitoring (surveys and wipe tests) will continue to be in compliance with all regulations. XCEL NDT LLC will continue to follow the Radiation Safety Program that it is currently utilizing to maintain all quality and safety requirements in regards to radioactive materials. It is not contemplated at the present time that any changes will be made to such program.
