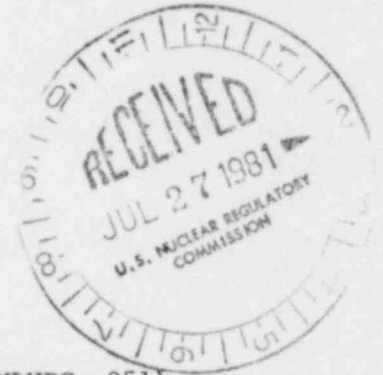

The purpose of this letter is to update the Referenced Report concerning flood damaged equipment at Wolf Creek Generating Station.

Work has progressed on restoring the pipe spools, mechanical components and electrical equipment to their original condition. Only three Deficiency Reports and one Nonconformance Report are still open of the original 24 Reports which were initiated to document the restoration or replacement of the 107 safety-related items that were affected.

We will submit a final report to you on or before October 15, 1981. Please advise if you need any additional information at this time.
