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

Dear Mr. Reed:

In accordance with your document production requests of March 24, 1981 and June 20, 1981, and our response of May 6, 1981, enclosed is a copy of the Callaway Plant Radiological Emergency Response Plan (RERP) dated 5/81. This document was revised in order to comport with the format of the Final Safety Analysis Report Site Addendum (FSAR), and was submitted as part of Revision 3 of the FSAR on May 15, 1981. Please note that the phrase, "Rev. 3, 5/81," added to the bottom right-hand corner of each page of the RERP, indicates the FSAR revision number and date of revision, not the RERP revision number.

RERP Rev. 3 includes the following minor corrections and additions to RERP Rev. 1, indicated below by underscoring, and deletions, as noted:

1. Table 4.1 (Sheet 2 of 3), Item 13.B:

"Any confirmed tornado within 10 miles of site."

2. Section 5.1, Item d, page 5-1:

"Radiation & Chemical Technician (2):"

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3. Chapter 1, pages 1-3 and 1-4:

"Emergency Duty Officer (EDO) - A designated member of the plant management staff who shall be assigned responsibility for the initial contact for problems where the operating Supervisor needs guidance, recommending action to the Operating Supervisor, and acting as the EPOM until the arrival of the Plant Superintendent. The EDO shall be available to be contacted by the Operating Supervisor at any time. One of the following shall be designated as the EDO for rotating periods:

- a. Assistant Plant Superintendent
- b. Superintendent, Operations
- c. Superintendent, Maintenance
- d. Superintendent, Engineering"

4. Section 5.2.1, Item a., page 5-2:

"Implementation of all in-plant operating and emergency procedures utilizing normal plant operations staff."

5. Section 5.3.1, page 5-5:

Delete the phrase "on-site" from the last sentence.

6. Table 5.1 (Sheet 2):

Delete the phrase "Local Support" from the Fire-fighting functional area.


7. Figure 5.2:

Delete all numbers in parenthesis under each position. Add a dotted line from Assistant Superintendent, Engineering Rad-Chem to the Plant Superintendent.

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8. Section 6.4.2.3., last sentence, page 6-13:
"In-plant supplies of potassium iodide will be maintained in the First Aid Room."
9. Section 7.1.1, paragraph 6, last sentence, page 7-1:
Delete the phrase "and photographs of components installed without layout specifications (e.g. field-run piping and instrument tubing.)"
10. Section 7.1.2, page 7-2:
Delete item "1. resuscitor"
11. Revision bars have been added to the left hand margin to indicate changes since the initial issue of the FSAR.
