
Subject: Virgil C. Summer Nuclear Station  
Potential Significant Deficiency  
10 CFR 50.55(e)

Dear Mr. O'Reilly:

On October 23, 1980, Mr. John K. Rausch at the NRC Region II office was notified of a potential significant deficiency as defined by 10 CFR 50.55 (e). The item involved damage to accumulator "A" isolation valve. A thirty day interim report was sent on October 24, 1980. Followup engineering evaluation dispositioned this item as not reportable by 10 CFR 50.55 (e) criteria. Subsequent to this disposition, the item was designated as LII 81-04-01 in an NRC Audit Report. It is, therefore, requested item 81-04-01 be closed due to the evaluation as non reportable.
