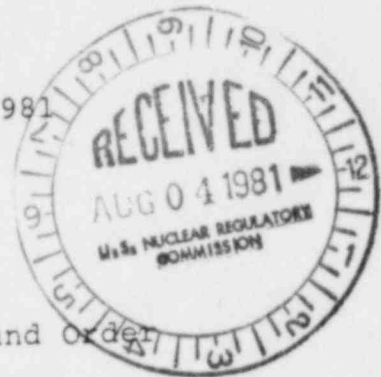
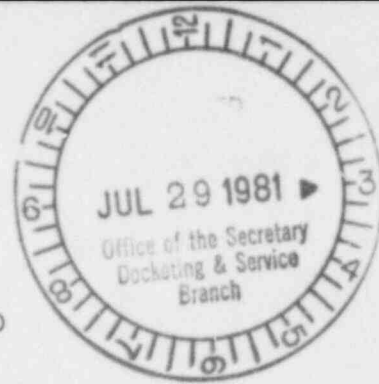

MOTION OF FLORIDA POWER & LIGHT COMPANY
FOR BRIEF EXTENSION OF TIME


On July 7, 1981, the Board issued a Memorandum and Order directing, inter alia, that the parties file by Tuesday, August 4, 1981, briefs addressing certain questions, and that the brief filed by Florida Power & Light Company ("FPL") include its complete response to the motion for summary disposition filed by Cities. FPL respectfully request that the time for this filing be extended to permit briefs to be served by hand delivery on all Board members and counsel in Washington, D.C., by the close of business Friday, August 7, 1981.^{*/} FPL requests this extension because of the volume of material which it has found necessary to review in preparing its brief and because of the logistical and clerical difficulties involved in preparing and assembling the evidentiary materials which FPL intends to submit as appendixes to its brief. Granting of the requested extension, coupled with a requirement for

hand service, should not delay for more than one day the Board's receipt of the filings. FPL requests that the time for filing of briefs by all other parties be similarly extended. Counsel for the Cities, the NRC Staff, the Department of Justice, Parsons & Whittemore, and Metropolitan Dade County have authorized counsel for FPL to state that those parties have no objection to granting of the relief requested in this motion.

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
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
