
Dear Sirs:



If Diablo Canyon is safe from nuclear accident and from earthquake it should be liscensed as soon as possible. We need the power that it can provide. It just does not make sense to scrap or convert so expensive and well planned an undertaking unless there is certain danger in opening it. I am willing to accept your verdict as to it's safety.
