Dear Commissioners,

I want to register my protest to the proposed opening of the Diablo Canyon Nuclear Power Plant. I feel that the unresolved issues regarding waste disposal and the potential health threat the wastes pose are sufficient to deny a license to operate Diablo Canyon. I feel there are also questions remaining about earthquake safety and vulnerability to terrorist attack which make Diablo Canyon an unwise choice for a power generating facility.

Liability limitations under the Price-Anderson act and the rising costs of nuclear fuel and the as yet undetermined costs of safe, effective waste disposal make Diablo Canyon Nuclear Facility uneconomical as well and an unnecessary burden on ratepayers and taxpayers. There are better alternatives. Please, for our sake and for our future generations, deny Diablo Canyon a license to operate.
