Dear Sir:

I was very pleased to read that the Atomic Safety and Licensing Appeal Board had found that the Diablo Canyon nuclear plant was designed and constructed to withstand any maximum credible earthquake. I hope the board's ruling will clear the way for a NRC permit to load fuel and conduct low power tests.

I was also pleased to read that the NRC's advisory committee on reactor safeguards had concluded that TMI Unit 1 can be restarted and operated

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without undue risk to the health and safety of the public." I urge you to do everything that you can to get Unit 1 back online.

Generally, I hope that in the future the NRC will take appropriate steps to streamline the nuclear power plant licensing process. We need nuclear power to produce the energy to re-industrialize America.
