

The Rockford League of Women Voters ("the League"), by its attorneys, objects to the First Round of Interrogatories directed to it by Commonwealth Edison Company, as follows:

INTERROGATORY NO. 1

1. The League objects to Interrogatory No. 1 on the ground that, given the present state of the record in this case (including without limitation the fact that the SER has not yet been filed, and also the fact that the Atomic Safety and Licensing Board has not yet ruled upon Commonwealth Edison's petition to reconsider the admission of numerous of the League's contentions), Interrogatory No. 1 is premature. Further, the League's investigation of the issues is continuing and the League has not yet determined what witnesses it expects to call at the hearing thereon.


2. The League objects to Interrogatory No. 2 for the reasons stated in its objection to Interrogatory No. 1.


