
SMALL SCALE EXERCISE  
NORTH ANNA POWER STATION  
JUNE 6, 1981

Pursuant to 10 CFR 50, Appendix E, a small scale emergency preparedness exercise was held at North Anna Power Station on June 6, 1981. The Virginia Electric and Power Company has included from the results of this exercise that adequate communication links exist and response agencies understand the emergency action levels. In addition, local and state police were tested as an additional component to the exercise.

Attached to this letter is a report of the exercise. In this report we identify 19 items of varying significance that were discussed during the critique held at the conclusion of the exercise. A status report on the disposition of these items is due to be issued by the station on August 15, 1981. The items of significance that concern communications protocol and techniques, operator training, and procedure modifications are the subject of a training session due to be held at the site the week of August 10, 1981. Both the company and the State Office of Emergency and Energy Services will participate in this session.
