In Ref. (3) you requested further information concerning Ref. (2). The following are Boston Edison's responses to that request.

Request:

With respect to your response to Item A, we note that you make no reference to including the requirements for performing a semi-annual review of all maintenance requests and an inspection of all red tags at the station in your station procedures.

Response:

The proposed semi-annual review of outstanding maintenance requests, and inspection of all red tags at the station shall be procedurally addressed as a permanent requirement by September 1, 1981.

Request:

With respect to your response to Item C, we note that you have not described the corrective actions taken and results achieved for this specific violation, although you do discuss corrective steps to avoid further violations.


