

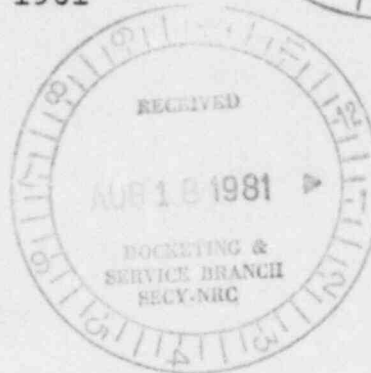

Gentlemen:

Transmitted herewith are Applicants' Proposed Findings of Fact and Conclusions of Law in the Form of a Partial Initial Decision. 
In that latter connection, we have been in contact with witnesses and potential witnesses on the matters to be covered


