Now comes Intervenor Commonwealth of Massachusetts and says
as follows:

1. Argument on exceptions taken to the Partial Initial Decision in the above-captioned matter has been scheduled by the Appeal Board for September 1, 1981 at 9:30 a.m. in Bethesda, Maryland. Because a prehearing conference on other issues in the same case has been scheduled by the Licensing Board for that same day, it appears that one of these two matters must be rescheduled.

2. Counsel for the Commonwealth of Massachusetts assigned to the appeal will be on vacation during the last two weeks of August, and had intended to return to work on September 1, 1981. Because of preparation time and travel time to Bethesda, if argument on the appeal continues to be scheduled for September 1st, counsel will


