This is in response to your letter of July 21, 1981 concerning Illinois Power Company's plans for alerting the public within the plume exposure pathway zone.

Illinois Power Company will have a prompt notification system in operation for Clinton Unit 1 by fuel load. The system will consist of sirens, tone activated radios or other acceptable means.

The area around Clinton Power Station consists of flat terrain, relatively low population density and a regular network of highways and country roads; at this time we do not foresee any problems that will hinder implementation of such a system.

As we progress through the design and implementation of this system, we will keep State and local officials informed.
