
Dear Mr. Denton:

Attached is the McGuire Nuclear Station procedure AP/1/A/5500/36, "Venting of Non-Condensable Gases from the Reactor Vessel Head." This procedure is being submitted pursuant to McGuire Operating License, NPF-9, Condition c.(11)i. to provide "information on procedures and testing including measures to preclude inadvertent operation."

Testing of the valves is accomplished by operation of the valves during the pre-startup venting of the Reactor Coolant System. Covers are placed over the switches for the valves to preclude inadvertent operation of the valves (Note Step 5.8 in the attached procedure).
