Three Mile Island Alert, Inc. hereby requests an extension of time in filing exceptions to the decision rendered August 27, 1981 by the Atomic Safety and Licensing Board, In the Matter of Metropolitan Edison Company, (Three Mile Island Nuclear Station, Unit 1), Docket No. 50-239 (Restart), Partial Initial Management Decision (Procedural Background and Management Issues).

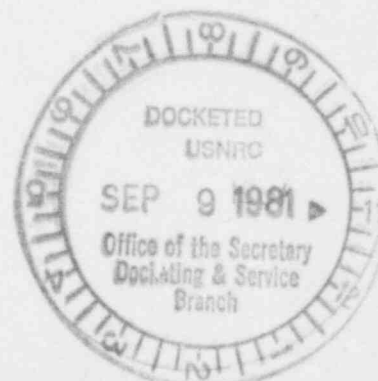
This extension is requested in light of the 10CFR 2.762 requirement the exceptions be filed within ten days, the fact that the Commission has ordered a simultaneous comment period before the Commission on the issue of immediate effectiveness, and considering the length of the partial decision. 
